Paediatric First Aid – Level 3 Training:

£25 per person (Payment must be made within 48hrs of booking a place)

PLEASE NOTE: It is not possible to make any name changes 2 weeks prior to the start of the course.

Special point to note:

Candidates must provide photographic ID to attend this course.

This accredited course is designed for those working or volunteering in the childcare sector – from childminders to nursery and crèche workers. Over 12 hours, candidates will receive a high level of training, to enable them to deal with first aid emergencies affecting babies and children.

The training meets the National Minimum Standards for Regulated Childcare, including changes to age range from 2016.

Please note: Part of this training is on a practical level, if you have any concerns or queries on course suitability please let us know prior to booking a place.

Basic Safeguarding Awareness Training:

Due to the confidentiality and sensitive nature of this course, please ensure that if accessing from home you are in a quiet area where no other family members or children are in the same vicinity.

Solihull Approach 2 Day Foundation Training

This training aims to increase emotional health and well-being, as well as introducing delegates to the developmental effects of childhood trauma in relation to working with children and their families. The Solihull Approach introduces a model for understanding

the impact of relationships on health and wellbeing and the impact of adverse childhood experiences on health and wellbeing. It supports effective and consistent approaches across agencies as a shared framework. The Solihull Approach training is designed for any practitioner working with babies, young children and school-aged children, young people and their families to support the use of the Solihull Approach from any agency.

Family Links Training

The programme introduces the principles and practice of the Nurturing Programme for staff working in Early Years settings. Staff will be trained in the use of the Nurturing Programme that enhances a positive and caring setting ethos.

0-3 Communication Pathway

This is online, free and takes approximately ½ a day to complete. It is a great place to start learning about children's speech and language development. It looks at how you can support the development of these skills on a day-to-day basis in your setting, and how to spot children and young people who might be struggling to develop these important skills: CPD online short course (speechandlanguage.org.uk)
